Graham is also co-author of "Hypnosis and Communication in Dentistry", a clinical textbook published by Quintessence.

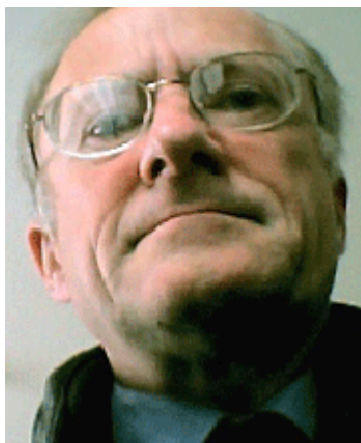
Dr Mark Gerald Lovell, BSc (hons), MBChB (hons), MRCPsych, PGDip (merit)
